Matt and Jack from "Restaurant Rescue" began by taking apart appliances in the kitchen. Most of the pieces are being cut up and recycled; some of the stainless-steel tables will be re-used in the new kitchen set-up.

We are re-doing the church kitchen to meet Commercial Kitchen standards. Intense planning and choreography are driving the project because it needs serious upgrades to surpass modern building codes for utilities and infrastructure standards.



Demolition of the wooden cabinets in the kitchen came next because wood doesn't meet code for modern commercial kitchens. It was a messy job but the crew from DRD Services made quick work of it. Below, the same view after an hour of heavy lifting.






The dumpster is loaded, and away it goes!

May 21 – Asbestos Abatement complete...ready for work to begin!




July 18, 2018

First, the electrical re-routing:






And the new gear waiting its turn:
