W.I.N. UPDATES (What's Important now) Strategies

Planning/Procedures/Process: Becky Moody discussed the electronic survey she is undertaking. There was discussion about the potential uses of a new CRM system.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

Capital Campaign - RENEW: An anonymous gift of \$100,000 was made for the refresh of the fellowship hall kitchen. The goal will be to make the kitchen commercially certified for mission uses and potential revenue generation.

Worship: A written report was received. Monika Stebbins discussed the highlights of the report, including music appreciation, summer worship, liturgist recruitment, and new hymnal.

Christian Education: Patrick Allred discussed upcoming curriculum changes and new direction.

Mission & Service: Becky Moody discussed the garden,

Community Outreach & Congregational Life: Refer to W.I.N. report. The lack of fellowship time hospitality volunteers was discussed.

Finance & Stewardship: Tom Selquist cannot continue to chair this committee due to professional conflict. Barbara Schuszler will take over the chair of this committee.

Properties: A written report was received. The Property Committee has \$63,000 of total proposed projects for the Summer of 2017 (front steps, sidewalk, and hallway stairs). In addition, there is a proposal for the low wall between the communion table and the organ pit for \$4,200 which would be funded the RENEW campaign. A **Motion** was approved to make this investment.
